## Introduction

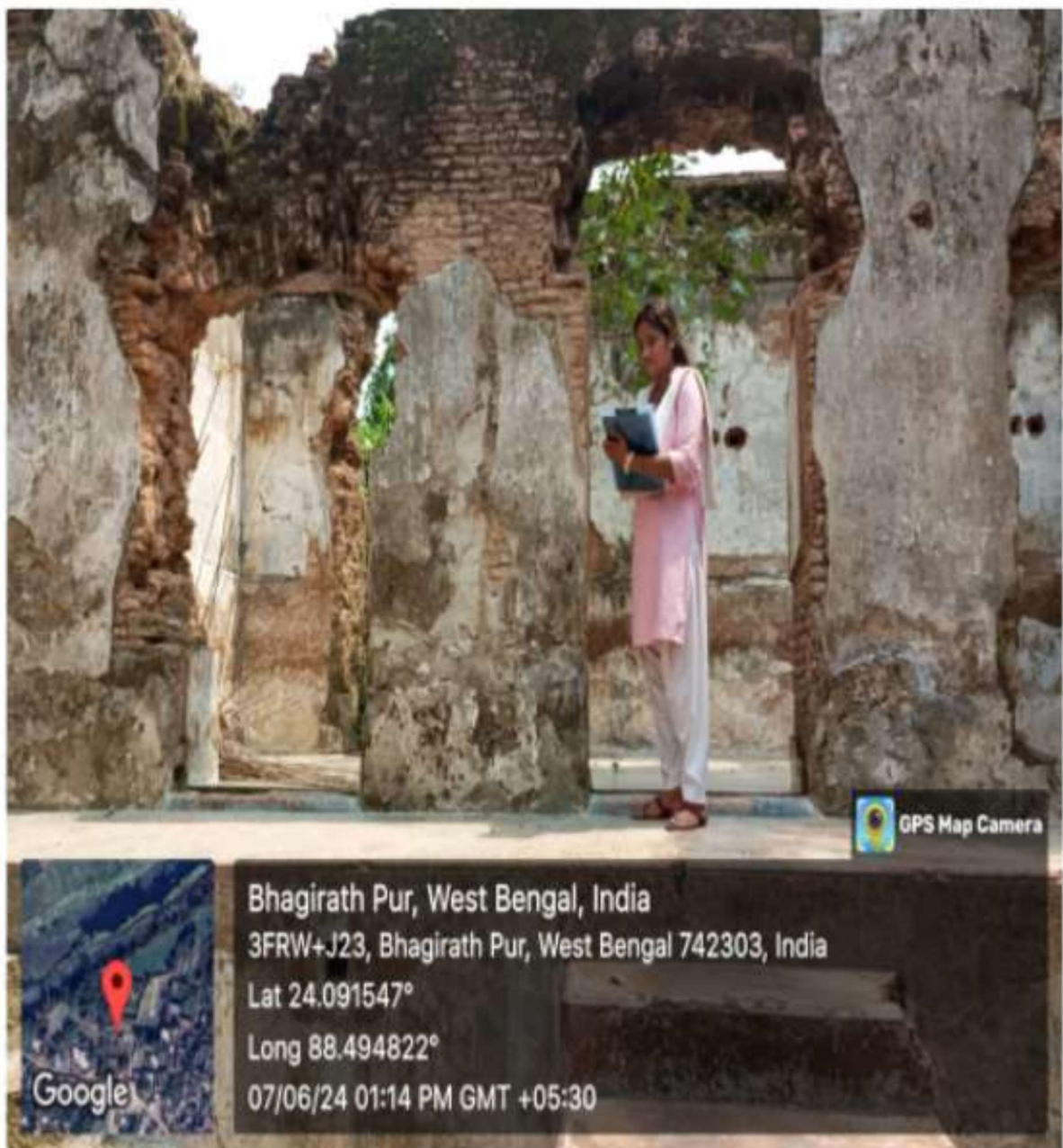
