Introduction:

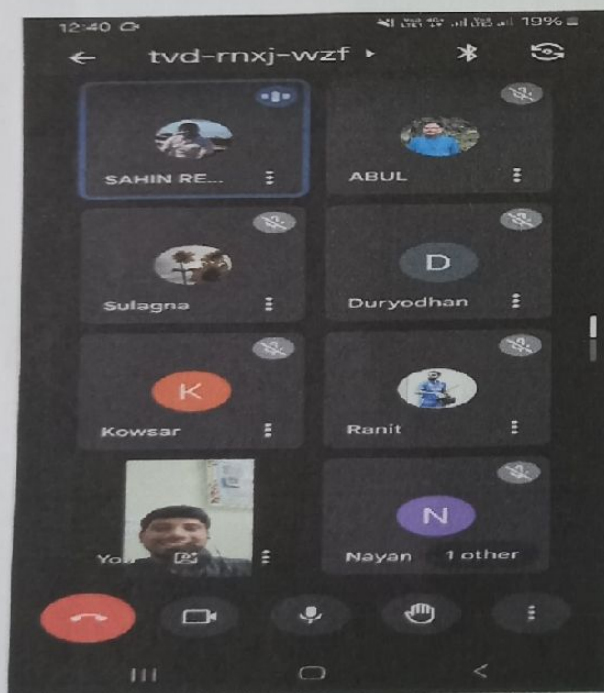
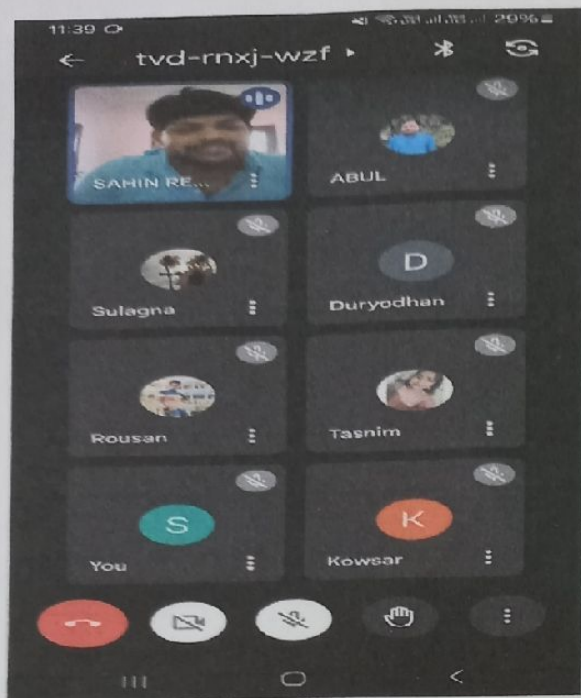
