


Session wise Result analysis of Geography department: 1<sup>st</sup> semester (2021-2022):

- 3. Out of the total students, 2 students were secured below 60% marks, those were known as moderate learner (2 of 9 i.e. 22.22%).


#### Recommendation:

### 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (2021-2022):




#### **Observations:**

### **Observations:**



#### **Observations:**



### Result analysis of 5th semester (2021-2022)




#### **Observations:**

## 6th semester (2021-2022):




## Observations:
